CONDITIONS OF PUBLICATION OF ARTICLES

To publish an article in issue № 110, 2026, you should fulfill the following conditions until April 30, 2026 inclusively:

→ to fill in the information about the author at [the link](#) or using a QR code

→ to send an article, which is executed as required, to the e-mail of the editorial office editor@chasopys.ps.npu.kiev.ua;



The editorial staff carries out the internal anonymous peer review (single-blind review - the reviewer knows the author, but the author does not know the reviewer). After the peer- review, the author receives an e-mail with the results of the review (The article is accepted for publication, or The article have to be revised).

After official confirmation and provision of payment details by the editorial board, the author pays publication fee.

→ to send a payment confirmation of publication fee.

The publication fee in Naukowyi Chasopys Dragomanov Ukrainian State University Series 5. Pedagogical sciences: reality and perspectives is **1400 UAH** for one article up to 12 pages. In case of exceeding the volume, each additional page is **50 UAH**. The publication fee covers the costs associated

with review, proofreading and editing of articles, layout of the collection and placement of its electronic version.

The editorial board accepts for free publication individual articles by postgraduate students enrolled in state-funded programs, provided that they comply with the established requirements and principles of academic integrity.

Along with the article, postgraduate

students enrolled in state-funded programs must submit a certificate from the postgraduate department confirming their enrollment. The certificate must bear the signature of the head of the postgraduate department and the official seal.

The electronic version of the journal is timely placed in public access on the publication's website.

If desired, the author of the article can order a **printed copy** of the journal. The cost of a printed copy is **UAH 800**, which must be paid in addition to the publication fee.

References, summaries and information about the author are also included in the volume of pages of the article.

REQUIREMENTS FOR THE DESIGN AND CONTENT OF SCIENTIFIC ARTICLES

Submitted articles, which violate the requirements, are not accepted for editing and publication.

WARNING! The maximum number of authors of one article is 5 people!

Format A 4; margins - 2 cm (lower) x 2 cm (upper), 3 cm (left) x 1.5 cm (right); paragraph indention- 1.25 cm; line spacing - 1.5 cm; font - Times New Roman; size - 14.

The minimum volume of the article is 12 full pages.

The maximum volume of the article is 18 full pages.

Language of article submission: Ukrainian, English.

Article structure:

1. UDC
2. Last name, first name, patronymic.
3. Title of the article (in Ukrainian and English).
4. Summary (1800-2100 printed characters) and keywords (8-10 words) - in Ukrainian and English.
5. The article text.
6. References are executed in accordance with DSTU 8302: 2015 "Information and documentation. Bibliographic reference. General principles and rules of composition".
To ensure the quality of scientific citations, the DOI of each source (if available) must be provided in the list of references.

7. References.

It is essential to comply with the requirements of the Ordinance of the Cabinet of Ministers of Ukraine "On Normalization of Transliteration of the Ukrainian Alphabet by Means of Latin Alphabet" dated January 27, 2010, when transliterating.

8. Information about the author (-s) is in Ukrainian and English: surname, name, patronymic; scientific degree, academic title (if any); job position, an organization where the author works, orcid-code, e-mail address.

PROHIBITION OF USING SCIENTIFIC WORKS OF THE OCCUPYING COUNTRY

It is prohibited citing and including in the reference list russian-language contributions published in any country, incl. papers written in other languages but published in russia and belarus.

The articles are checked for plagiarism using the software StrikePlagiarism.com developed by the Polish company Plagiat.pl.
